#### Romans 8:16-17 (ESV)

<sup>16</sup> The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, <sup>17</sup> and if children, then heirs—heirs of God and fellow heirs with Christ, provided we suffer with him in order that we may also be glorified with him.

#### 1 Corinthians 12:4-7 (ESV)

<sup>4</sup> Now there are varieties of gifts, but the same Spirit; <sup>5</sup> and there are varieties of service, but the same Lord; <sup>6</sup> and there are varieties of activities, but it is the same God who empowers them all in everyone. <sup>7</sup> To each is given the manifestation of the Spirit for the common good.

## 1 Peter 4:8-10 (ESV)

<sup>8</sup> Above all, keep loving one another earnestly, since love covers a multitude of sins. <sup>9</sup> Show hospitality to one another without grumbling. <sup>10</sup> As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace:

# Romans 12:10-13 (ESV)

<sup>10</sup> Love one another with brotherly affection. Outdo one another in showing honor. <sup>11</sup> Do not be slothful in zeal, be fervent in spirit, serve the Lord. <sup>12</sup> Rejoice in hope, be patient in tribulation, be constant in prayer. <sup>13</sup> Contribute to the needs of the saints and seek to show hospitality.

# 1 Corinthians 14:1 (NIV)

Follow the way of love and eagerly desire gifts of the Spirit, especially prophecy.

#### 1 – Our own growth

We may have come out of the last year in several ways. We may have been fruitful or stagnant; celebrating or disappointed. What have been the spiritual highs and lows of 2018? How has community helped?

Read Romans 8:16-17. Throughout 2018 did you feel secure in your standing as a child and fellow-heir with Jesus? How does insecurity in this area limit spiritual growth? How can we root ourselves in the truth in these verses?

We all have Spiritual Gifts given to us by God. Have you seen growth in any of them in particular recently? Gifts are listed in 1 Corinthians 12:4-11,28 and Romans 12:6-8.

## 2 - Our own growth

What does 1 Peter 4:8-10 reveal about the purpose of God giving us Spiritual Gifts? What does this reveal about why God puts us in community?

Read Romans 12:10-13. How do we "outdo one another in showing honour"? What is an example?

Taking Romans 12:10-13, how can you make it a roadmap for how to live in and conduct ourselves in 2019?

Read on to verses 14-19. What stands out to you on how we can grow individually and as a community?
