1 – HUMBLE FIRST

Over the next few weeks we will be based in 2 Chronicles 7:14 which lists four things that God's people need to do. Why do you think humility is listed first? What do you think about the quote from St. Augustine?

What is the significance about the order of the next three keys? Is it surprising that "turn from their wicked ways" comes last? Why do you think it is last? What cycles do we get caught in when we put it further up the list?

Have you ever had a moment or experience with God that transformed your life? How was it humbling? How did your attitude and relationship with God change?

Does humility equal absolute dependence on God? If so, what does a life lived in that truth look like to you?

2 - MOSES, MEEKNESS & MEETING GOD

Numbers 12:3 recounts Moses as most humble person on earth. How do you think Moses' various encounters with God produced this humility? Do you think Moses' was humbled though these encounters or did he have to be humble first before God would use him?

Moses setup a tent to regularly meet with God (Ex 33:7). How do you commune with God? Do you feel like to need to make more space in your life? How does spending time with God produce humility for you?

3 – GETTING OUT OF THE BOX

Mike said that enemy tries to contain Christians in a box so that they are not effective. What strategies does the enemy employ to do this? What strategies does the bible give us to resist the devil?

How can unconfessed sin in someone's life hold them back? How does pride work to keep sin hidden? How is the church to be a safe place for confession? Do you feel you can be vulnerable here?

Read Ezekiel 36:22-27. How can you see humility and healing woven together in this passage? Can we ask God to soften our hearts?
