1 – GRATITUDE

Read Colossians 3:15-17. **This tells us to be thankful twice, why is thankfulness and gratitude to God so important right now?**

Ken said; “*Celebrate what God has done, and is doing, knowing He is faithful to do the rest.*” **How easy has it been to grateful in this season? How does gratitude cultivate a pliable and tender heart?**

2 – A RENEWED MIND

Ken said; “*a renewed mind is a power tool that the Holy Spirit uses to adjust our attitudes and emotions.*” **Why do our attitudes and emotions need to be adjusted at times? How does this line up with Romans 12:2?**

Ken said; “In this season the enemy wants to sow things into our hearts that, when this season ends, we still have within us.” **What are examples of those things? How can we fight against this?**

3 – DECLARE WHAT GOD HAS SPOKEN TO YOU

Ken said; “*don't allow hardships, unanswered questions in these times to cancel the revelation of who God is and has said.*” **Why is continuing to go back to the truth and promises that God has given us so important?**

4 – FAITHFUL WITH WHAT YOU HAVE RECEIVED

Read 2 Timothy 1:14. **What do you think is the “good deposit” is here? What has been entrusted to you in the same way? Why does it need to be guarded?**

5 – REMAIN HUNGRY

Ken said that there are two things that cause hunger within us; desperation and appetite. **How does feeding on God and His word create an appetite in us for more of Him?**
